1. Who is responsible for the processing of my personal data?

2. What will my personal data be processed for?

Your personal data will be used for the following:

- **CONTACT US:** Deal with enquiries, concerns and/or requirements expressed through this means concerning products or services of the companies of the group.
- **JOB OFFERS:** Go through job applications in the selection processes of staff that are organised in each of the companies of the corporate group. If you send us your curriculum vitae, it is assumed that you accept the fact that we will keep it indefinitely so that you can take part in current and future selection processes, regardless of your right to cancel or object to the processing of your personal data at any time free of charge. Moreover, it is assumed that you are aware of the fact that Venanpri is an international group, which means that your job application might be passed on to any of the companies of the group that are interested in you, which might be located outside the EU.
- **SOCIAL NETWORKING SITES:** Provide information about sector-related topics and the companies from the group and interact (using videos, photos, comments, raffles) with the users of social networking sites.

3. Marketing messages.

Supplying your personal data in any of our registration forms is considered to be a pre-contractual relationship, whereby it is assumed that we can send you information that we think might be of interest to you. 4. How long will my personal data be kept for?

5. What data do I have to supply?

6. Will my personal data be passed on to third parties or sent to other countries?

Your rights.
